Knowing God **Jim Packer**

How can we know God, what is he like, and how should it change us? As it covers topics such as the trinity, election, God's wrath, and God's sovereignty, this classic book redirects our attention to the simple, deep truth that to know God is to love His Word. It fires the heart with the wonder, glory and the joy of knowing God.

The Cross of Christ **John Stott**

Why is the universal symbol of the Christian faith a gruesome reminder of a horrible means of execution? This magnificent book explains the significance of the cross and answers the objections commonly brought against Biblical teaching on the atonement. The cross is central to our faith. This book will help you understand why, and what it means to live as Christians under the cross.

Dig Deeper **Nigel Beynon and Andrew Sach**

How do we get to grips with the Bible? What do we do when we find a passage difficult to understand?
